Welcome to the 2019 Salt Lake Criterium benefiting the Utah Food Bank. Criterium racing has been a staple in and around downtown Salt Lake City for years. Courses have included the Pioneer Park Crit, The Sugarhouse Crit, and also the Salt Palace State Championship. This race will take place around the Gateway Mall.

This is a USA Cycling Sanctioned and USA CRITS Series points race. USA Cycling rules apply.

A current USAC license is required, non-licensed cyclists are invited to race with a one-day license.

Late Registration is available, in-person, on July 20th. If registering on the Day-Of (July 20th), you must be registered at least 30 minutes before your designated Criterium start time.

All participants must have a valid 2019 USAC racing license. One-day licenses are available for purchase for \$10 for amateur fields.

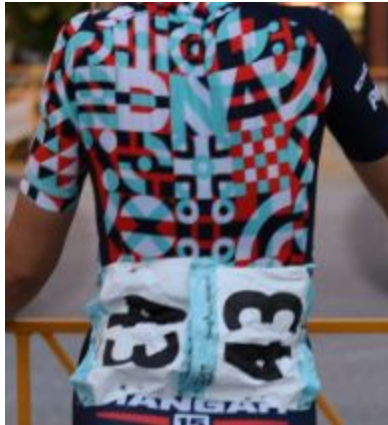
Packet Pick-Up and Sign-In

Registration and pick up will open at 12:00 pm and is located near the Start Finish line. You may pick up your race packet, bib number and sign in up to 30 minutes before your scheduled Criterium Start Time. Please remember to have your current USAC license available at packet pick-up and USAC waiver signed.

General Information

Race Numbers:

ALL fields will have two numbers and they will be placed on each side of the jersey as seen below.



Please take care in placing the numbers correctly so the finish line cameras and officials can read them.

Racers with incorrectly placed numbers may be subject to a fine per the USAC rulebook and may not have their times/placing recorded. Please do not trim, cut, crumple or alter the numbers in anyway or you may be fined and have to purchase new numbers.

Finishes, Prizes and Primes:

After completing your race, please do not congregate at the finish line. Never cross the finish line in the opposite direction or a second time in the same direction. Be aware of the finish line cameras!

- **YOU MUST SHOW YOUR RACE NUMBER AND RACE LICENSE TO CLAIM PRIZES AND PRIMES.**
- Racer must provide a legible signature when claiming a prize.
- Event prizes and primes will be available after each race's results have been made final at the payout tent.
- Special attention should be paid to the timeliness of protest and appeals.
- If you win over \$600, you must fill out a W-9 form before receiving payout. Forms will be available at the payout tent.
- All prizes **MUST** be picked up before the end of the event.

Weather:

We expect races to be run regardless of weather conditions. Please remember to stay hydrated. Officials reserve the right to reduce race distances if necessary for racers' safety.

Keep it Clean at the Venues:

Please respect all private and public properties by following all local laws, not littering and using the toilets at the venue. There will be signage to clearly identify restrooms around the venue. Dropping wrappers and or anything else is considered littering.

Salt Lake Twilight Criterium

Saturday, July 20th 2019 – 1:40 PM Start

Course Description:

The 1.1 mile criterium will take place on closed roads in and to the west of the Gateway Mall. Start/Finish will be in the plaza of the Gateway. From there riders will head north to 50N and turn left to head to 500 W. They will then go south on 500 W until 100 S where they will turn right and start heading west towards 600 W. At 600 W they will turn left and head south again until they reach 200 S where they will turn left again to head east and back to the Gateway Mall. They will turn left on Rio Grande Street to enter the Gateway Mall and head north through the center of the mall until they reach the finish.



Please arrive early to ensure you can register, stage and are ready to race at your designated start time. If you are registering day-of, you must be registered at least 30 minutes before your designated start time.

Look for the registration tent when you arrive for any additional information or announcements.

Getting There and Parking:

South Bound. When traveling south on I-15, exit at 400 South – Exit 307. Head east on 400 south until you reach 400 west. Turn left or north to head towards the Gateway Mall.

North Bound. When traveling north on I-15, exit at the 600 South – Exit 306. Head Easton 600 south until you reach 400 west. Turn left or north to head towards the Gateway Mall.

Parking. Parking is available in the Gateway mall. It can be accessed from 400 West. It is an UNDERGROUND parking garage so make sure you have no bikes on the roof. There will be reminder signs at the entrances to remove roof top bikes. You may be able to find street parking to the west near the Sun Trapp or many other parking lots around downtown. Do NOT park on the course.

IF PARKING UNDERGROUND BE SURE TO NOT HAVE A BIKE ON YOUR CAR ROOF!

Warming up / pre and post race:

Because there will be racing from 1:40 PM to 9:30 PM, please take care when crossing or moving about the course. There will be course marshals throughout the course that will assist in crossing the race course. You are not allowed on course to warm up except as allowed by the officials. Never ride in the opposite direction of the race or traffic.

Wheel Pit:

There will be a wheel pit located on the course, it is the racers responsibility to label their wheels and place them in the wheel pit. Officials will announce when the Free Lap rule equivalent will be in place.
