USA CRIT Series

About USA CRITS - Now in its 15th year, the USA CRITS is the premiere cycling series in the United States. USA CRITS was developed by Gene Dixon to feature criterium riders and to offer venues, teams, and riders the ability to excel in a unique discipline of cycling. Starting in 2018, an effort to build the sport toward greater sustainability was taken on with the USA CRITS TV project. The events that form USA Crits showcase the ideals that make criterium racing an American legacy - challenging courses, which showcase arts and entertainment districts, a large and growing base of spectators, broad community support, and strong marketing opportunities for partners.

Eligibility General Categories

All riders must present a current USA Cycling License or a UCI International License. Riders may only race in the category that is shown on their license and age groups as listed in the event Technical Guide.

General Rules

- Race day packet pickup will be at registration for each race venue. Registration is available up to 30-minutes prior to the start of each event.
- Race numbers are not transferable.
- A valid racing license must be shown at packet pick
- You may only race in the category for which you have a license or in the appropriate age category. Your appropriate age category is the age you will be as of December 31, 2021.
- All registered riders who did not complete the online waiver, will be required to complete and sign the USA Cycling Accident Waiver and Release of Liability at packet pickup.
- Riders under the age of 18 will also require the signature of a parent or legal guardian.
- No refunds will be given.
- Two (2) bib numbers will be issued for the D1 Men and Women. One (1) bib for all other categories.

Miscellaneous Rules

- Disc brakes are legal under USAC rules
- All Racers must queue in the designated staging corral 15 min before the start of their race.
- Free lap rule is in effect but ends with a determine number of laps remaining and will be announced at the start line of each race by the Chief Referee for all races on Saturday and Sunday.
- All racers are responsible for knowing the course and following USA Cycling rules.
- Special attention should be paid to the timeliness of protests and appeals.
- Protests and appeals must be made within the time limits established in the USAC Rules.

Medical Services

A fully staffed first aid station and EMSA will be located on each course throughout the weekend. Look for the standard “red cross” flag for the First Aid station.

Bib Numbers

- Each race packet will contain a set of two (2) race numbers for D1 Men and Women, one (1) number for all other categories. Numbers may not be folded or trimmed. You will receive a second number if you are racing in more than one race category.
- Number must be worn on the right side for all events and the bottom should be aligned with the side seam of the jersey (vertical orientation).
- If you lose your number, you will be charged a \$10 fee for a replacement number.
- Race Numbers are the same for both days

Finishes, Prizes, and Primes

- After finishing, please do not congregate at the finish line. Be aware of the finish line cameras – do not cross the finish line after the finish.
- D1 Men & Women payouts are cash, all other categories are awards/prizes as they apply
- YOU MUST SHOW YOUR RACE NUMBER AND RACE LICENSE TO CLAIM PRIZES AND PRIMES.
- Only the racer himself/herself can claim prizes. Racer must provide a legible signature when claiming a prize.
- Saturday and Sunday Event Prizes and Primes will be available after each race’s results have been made final at the payout tent at each venue.
- Special attention should be paid to the timeliness of protests and appeals.
- Omnium prizes will be available following the standard 15-minute protest period on Sunday. All results will be posted on www.yourresults.live no printed results will be posted onsite.
- If you win over \$600, you must fill out a W-9 form before receiving a payout. Forms will be available at the registration tent.
- All prizes must be picked up before the end of the weekend!

Doping Control

- Anti-doping inspections may be carried out by USADA (United States Anti-Doping Agency). If a rider is requested to be screened, their race number will be posted at the USADA board or USADA personnel will directly inform the racer. It is the responsibility of each racer to check the board and to report to the USADA location. Failure to appear will result in a positive test result. Alternates must also present themselves until released by USADA.

Awards Protocol

Podiums

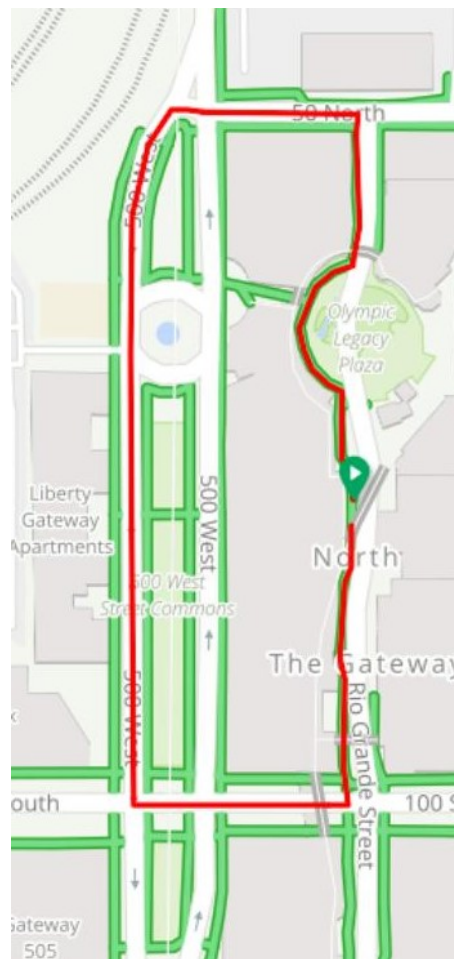
- The top three D1 Men and D1 Women must wear their full team uniform to each awards presentation. The podiums for each criterium will take place 20 min following the finish of the last race, women first followed by the men.
- All other events will also have a podium ceremony. Top three finishers are to be at the podium 15 min following their race. After the next race has started, we will start the podium ceremony.

Course Map



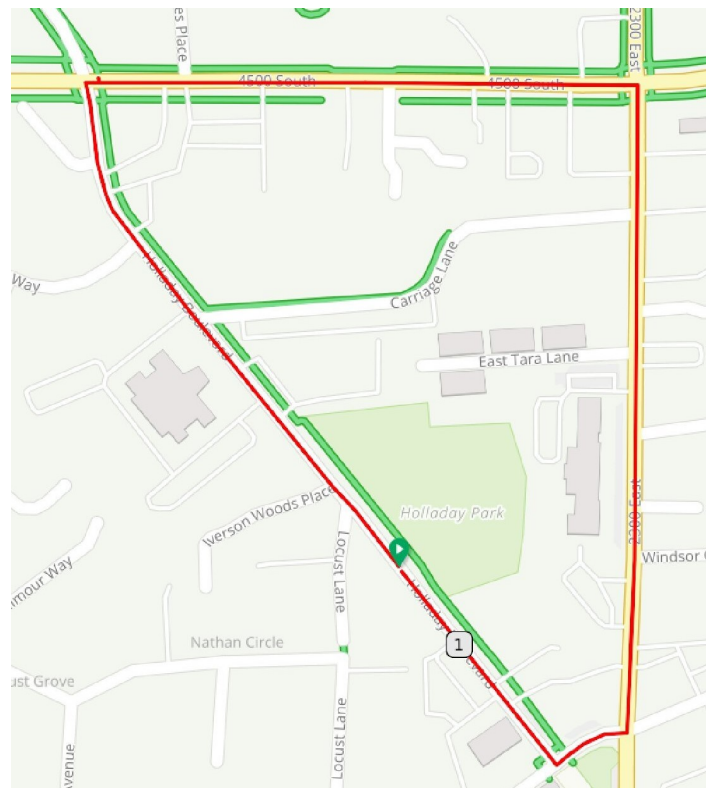

This course is a “triangle” with the first two turns almost appearing as one. The course features a gradual climb, shorter descent, and a long finishing straight with the finish line visible from 500. This will test the lead out trains as they set up their sprinters.

Emergency Medical Services

We are excited that the University of Utah Health will be providing onsite medical support for the Salt Lake Criterium. Each venue will be staffed with support doctors and paramedics. Medical equipment and supplies will also be provided.

The medical support station will have a side-by-side vehicle so they can reach any a crash site quickly. If any person needs to be transported to a hospital, it will be done with the support of the Unified Fire Department and Salt Lake City Fire Department.

- Side by Side will be located with the EMS Station at all times.
- EMS personnel will make the decision if a rider needs to be transported to the hospital, EMS personnel will make the call for transport
